- A deliberate wrong doing contrary to official examination rules designed to place a candidate at an unfair advantage or disadvantage, (Wilayat, 2009 quoted in Akaranga & Ongong, 2013).
 - A misconduct or improper practice, before, during or after any examination by examinees or others with a view to obtaining good results by fraudulent means (Arakaranga and Ongong, 2013).

Examination MALPRACTICE

- Examination malpractice has become common in institutions of learning at all levels.
- Every examination period comes with new and ingenious ways of cheating.
- The examination process has become endangered and if we don't act swiftly, the credibility of TEVET qualifications may be threatened.
- If this trend is not curtailed, Certificates will no longer reflect skills and competences.
